Discipleship/Stewardship Campaign to Kick Off in October

The men's group will meet on **Saturday, September 17** and on **Saturday, October 8** both at **8:30 AM**. As always, breakfast will be a part of the gatherings.





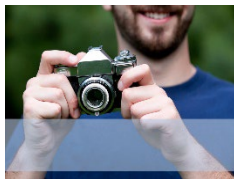
