This baptismal font originally belonged to the Reverend Nils Nordgren (December 20, 1839 - January 30, 1921) who was Vivienne's paternal great-great-great-great grandfather. Born in Sweden, he immigrated to the United States with his wife Britta and family in April 1868.

Reverend Nordgren was minister of the Swedish Evangelical Lutheran Church of Galva, Illinois when it was built in 1912. That church still stands today and in 1962 was renamed Messiah Lutheran Church.

This font has been used for the baptisms of generations of Vivienne's family members, including her mother (Hannah), grandfather (Justin) and and many, many others.
