HEY KIDS! Come next Sunday, May 18th at 4:30 and decorate a flowerpot. There will be food and games as well! Bring friends!!!


LOOKING AHEAD – On Sunday, May 25 at 3 PM the Ramsey Wind Symphony will present a free concert here in our sanctuary.
