Whatever you do, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus. Colossians 3:17



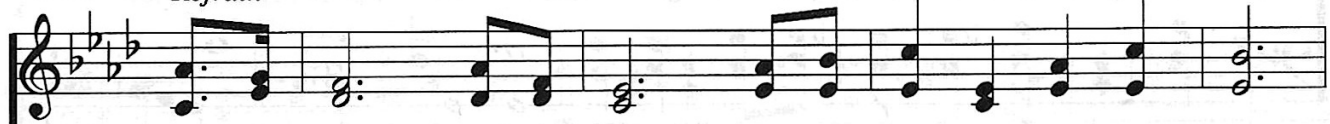

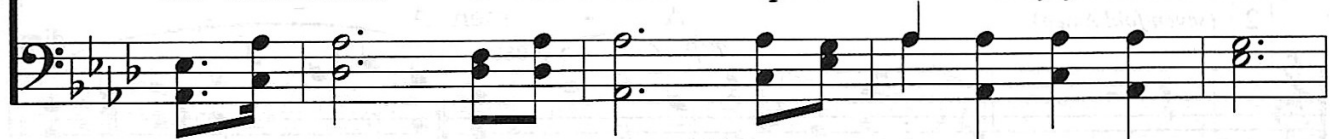
