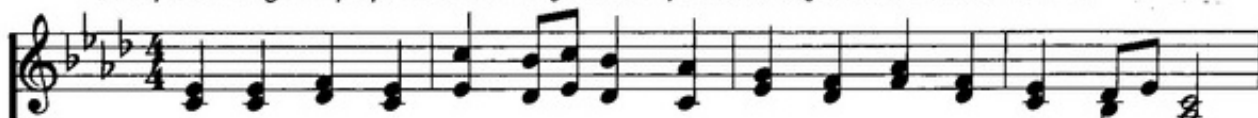

3. God is speak-ing by His Spir-it, Speak-ing to our hearts a-gain;



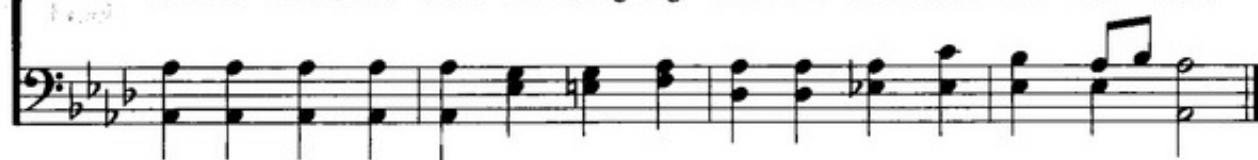
Each from age to age pro-claim-ing God, the one, the righ-teous Lord.
